Department of English Criteria for Reviewing the Teaching Performance of Designation B Candidates

The criteria used to review the teaching performance of Designation B candidates in the Department English parallels those used in the review of tenure-system faculty performance.

The Chair and Associate Undergraduate Chair of the Department will review the following materials submitted by Designation B candidates:

- 1) SIRS teaching evaluations for the last six semesters of courses taught in the Department
- 2) Course syllabi for the last six semesters of courses taught in the Department
- 3) A 2-3 page statement of teaching accomplishments and approaches to teaching used in courses taught over the last six semesters in the Department, focusing on pedagogy and innovative practices.

These materials must demonstrate excellent in teaching, as demonstrated by SIRS composite scores generally in the 1-2 range, quality of syllabi, and quality and cogency of the teaching statement.
